SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A LARGE-SCALE EMR CONVERSION WITH THE RIGHT PARTNER

MAINTAINING QUALITY CARE DURING AN EMR UPDATE

The Affordable Care Act brought about a wave of change in the healthcare industry, including reimbursement increases for hospitals that adopted electronic medical record (EMR) systems by 2014. This created a challenge for many facilities, such as the University of California at San Francisco Medical Center (UCSFMC), who needed to train their staff on these new systems while maintaining quality patient care.

To accomplish this, UCSFMC partnered with Fastaff, a Rapid Response® travel nurse staffing company that could provide expertise and support during the transition.
